They stripped and beat him and went off leaving him half-dead. A priest came along, but when he saw him, he passed by. Likewise a Levite came to the place, and when he saw him, he passed by on the other side of the road. But a Samaritan traveler who came upon him was moved with compassion at the sight. He cared for the victim, poured oil and wine over his wounds and bandaged them. Then he lifted him up on his own animal, took him to an inn and cared for him. BIBLE STORY: Based on John 20: 11-18

Early on Sunday morning, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb where Jesus' body had been buried. She saw that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance to the tomb.

Mary stood by the tomb when she saw two angels sitting in the place where Jesus' body had been. The angels asked Mary, "Why are you crying?" She answered, "Because someone has taken my Lord away, and I don't know where to find him."

Then Mary turned around. She saw Jesus standing there, but she did not recognize him. Jesus said to her, "Why are you crying?" Thinking he was the gardener, Mary said to him, "If you have taken him away, tell me where you have laid him and I will go and find him."

Jesus said, "Mary!" Now Mary knew that this was Jesus. She said to him, "Rabbouni" which means teacher. Jesus said to her, "Go to my friends and

tell them, 'I am returning to my Father and to your Father, to my God and your God.'”

Mary went to the disciples and said, "I have seen the Lord!" And she told them all that Jesus had said to her. **THE WORD OF THE LORD**

At every Eucharist we do what Jesus did with his friends the night before he died. During a meal, Jesus took bread. He gave thanks and praise. He broke the bread, gave it to his friends, and said:

**TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND EAT IT
FOR THIS IS MY BODY
WHICH WILL BE GIVEN UP FOR YOU.**

Then Jesus took a cup of wine. He gave thanks and praise. He blessed the cup, gave it to his friends, and said:

**TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND DRINK FROM IT,
THIS IS THE CHALICE OF MY BLOOD, THE BLOOD OF THE NEW
AND ETERNAL COVENANT, WHICH WILL BE Poured OUT FOR
YOU AND FOR MANY FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS. DO THIS
IN MEMORY OF ME.**

Let us proclaim the mystery of faith: **WE PROCLAIM YOUR DEATH, O LORD, AND PROFESS YOUR RESURRECTION UNTIL YOU COME AGAIN.**

Lord, because you love us, you invite us to come to your table.
