Altar serving is an important ministry of the Church. Altar servers, as ministers, are participants in the liturgy along with the Priest. Becoming an altar server requires a commitment from both the student and the parents.

Altar servers sign up to serve for masses including Sunday Masses and holy day Masses. Servers should serve one mass per month to stay current on their responsibilities. Altar servers and parents must realize this ministry is a twelve month commitment, including holidays, summer, and school vacations.
