“But the hour is coming, and is now here, when true worshipers will worship the Father in Spirit and Truth; and indeed the Father seeks such people to worship Him.” When I came back from Kenya I shared a story of how I celebrated mass in a church without a roof. The wind blew the dust and I had to protect the wine in the chalice with my vestment so that no dust would enter the wine.

After that experience, I bought them 50 sheets of roofing. I took a leap of faith and promised them that I have more than 100 friends who would help with the hundred extra sheets needed to help with roofing the church. I want to share with you very good news. I had more than a hundred friends who did step up. I received a little more than \$5,000 dollars.

We bought all 150 sheets they needed for the church and purchased two big trees (as they requested). They are in the process of sowing timbers which they will use in roofing. We also purchased the doors and the windows for the church. Thanks to all of you who took a leap of faith with me and decided to help this poor community of Wema in Pondo parish in Kenya. I’m learning a lot about roofing. I believe the Lord wants us to help them finish roofing this church and I will make sure it happens. I look forward to sharing with you a picture of the finished, roofed church when it is completed. I hope some of you will visit one day and

see the church you helped to roof.

For me this is just one example of worshipping the Lord in spirit and truth. We are able to recognize Jesus in those who are sick, in jail, hungry, naked, strangers, thirsty or in need and we can identify with them. **“Then the king will say to those at his right hand, ‘Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me!’.”**
