This page is to be signed and returned with the essay composed by the applicant

1. All entries must be postmarked by February 21, 2011.
2. Must maintain a "C" grade point average.
3. Use Standard English language in the essay entitled: *What It Means to be a Catholic Woman in the World Today*. Essay should be 300 words or less, typed and double spaced on an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet.
4. Submit two letters of recommendation. One letter each from your school counselor, Pastor, Youth Minister or non-family member.
5. Scholarship to be awarded in the summer of 2011.
6. This is a four-year renewable scholarship. The scholarship will be terminated if the awardee leaves college/university before the completion of four years.
7. In September and January, \$500 scholarship payment will be sent to the College/University upon receipt of previous term's transcript. Transcripts are to be sent to
