BE WITH ME, LORD

Today, we hear Moses and the Israelites pray as they offer the firstfruits of their harvest. They recount their oppression at the hands of the Egyptians and express that, in their struggle, they turned to the Lord. God brought them out of Egypt to a "land flowing with milk and honey" and, in gratitude and awe, the Israelites bow down before the Lord.

On this First Sunday of Lent, there is much we can learn from the Israelites and apply to our Lenten journey. Let us turn to the Lord when we struggle, knowing that he hears our cry and sees our affliction, toil, and oppression. What are some ways you can turn to God, our refuge and fortress, when you are troubled? Consider writing a prayer for when you find yourself struggling this Lenten season. For inspiration for the prayer, look to today's psalm: "*Be with me, Lord, when I am in trouble. / My refuge and fortress, my God in whom I trust.*"

After their deliverance, the Israelites set the firstfruits of their harvest down before the Lord and "*bow down in his presence.*" In this season of dying to ourselves to grow closer to God, let us detach ourselves from the gifts we have been given and return them to God in praise. What are some ways you can recognize God's presence daily? Consider ending your days with a prayer in gratitude, for we know that God raised Jesus from the dead, and we "*will be saved.*"

Institution into the Ministry of Reader

Liturgy date: February 22, 2025

Congratulations to Mark Parrish! On February 22, 2025, Most Rev. Mark Bartosic presided at the Rite of Institution into the Ministry of Reader and welcomed him into that ministry at the Chapel of the Immaculate Conception, University of Saint Mary of the Lake in Mundelein.

At the institution, Bishop Bartosic charged that Mark Parrish be faithful in handing on the Word of God, so that it may grow strong in the hearts of His people. Additionally, being an instituted Reader also means “taking on a special office within the Christian community.” Besides proclaiming the word in the liturgical assembly, an instituted Reader is responsible for:

- instructing children and adults in the faith;
- preparing them to receive the sacraments worthily;
- bringing the message of salvation to those who have not yet received it.

This is an awesome responsibility. But it is part of the continuing discernment process as Mark moves forward on his journey and listens to God's plan for him in future ministry.

During formation this year, Mark is attending academic courses which may include Church History, Old Testament, New Testament, Ecclesiology, Spiritual Theology, and Introductory Homiletics. He also participates in Theological Reflection Groups and attended a cohort retreat prior to his institution as Reader. This year he is engaged in a Service to the Word field education. He attends monthly spiritual direction and is present for numerous formation sessions as he continues his journey on the Candidate Stage toward the Order of Deacon.

Presently, we are blessed to have nearly 550 active deacons in the Archdiocese of Chicago.

Please keep in your prayers Mark, his wife (Cathy) and family, and all candidates in formation, that they might continue to answer God's call to serve His Church.

What the Devil Doesn't Have

The devil knows all the rules. The devil knows all the Bible verses. He probably knows them better than you do (certainly better than I do).

He knows them so well that here, in today's Gospel, he thinks he can outsmart the Son of God. He thinks he can out-argue him.

See, the thing you need to know about the devil is that he could have a master's degree in theology. Maybe even a doctorate. But have you ever met a master's student, or even a doctoral one, who doesn't have a particular passion for what they're studying? I sure have.

The devil didn't rebel against God because he didn't understand

God's will. He rebelled because he understood God's will perfectly — and he didn't like it.

The devil knows that Jesus is human, and so in today's Gospel he employs all the very best tricks he has for getting humans to break. Physical hunger. Insecurity and a desire for power. The yearning to appear learned and wise.

The devil will try these things with us, too — this Lent, and throughout our lives.

It doesn't work with Jesus, because, of course, Jesus is not just human. He can feel temptation, but he will not submit to it. But how are we supposed to do the same? We're not divine. We're just human.

Well, here's the thing. We may be only human, but as Christians, we have a secret weapon. (No, it's not a master's degree in theology. Some of you may have that, but it probably doesn't make you holier.)

We have a love of what the devil has renounced — those things belonging solely to God. Truth. Joy. Humility. Sanctifying sacrifice.

Let the love of those things carry you through this Lent, and beyond.

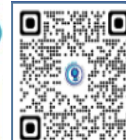
