LIGHT OF HOPE IN THE DARKNESS

Hope and joy are recurring themes in the readings and prayers on the Fourth Sunday of Lent. Midway through Lent, just as we begin to weary in our resolve, the readings remind us of God's love and the eternal life that awaits, and the prayers relate the Christian response of joy. The entrance antiphon begins, "*Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her,*" recalling for us that Lent is also a season for joy.

The liturgical color varies from the season's violet to rose today to visually encourage us. This day points to the reconciliation that is ours because of Christ's death and resurrection. And we have merited none of this. Only by the mercy of God do we live in Christ. As the reading from Ephesians states, "*It is the gift of God; it is not from works so no one may boast.*"

Some accept the gift of faith, but as the Gospel states, "*The light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light.*" At baptism, we received the light of Christ and, with that light, join Christ in dispelling darkness. This week, be aware that you carry the light of Christ within you and can bring others to it.

Jesus taught Nicodemus that God loves the world and desires to save it. *In what ways do you show love and respect for our world?*

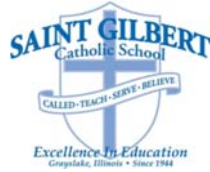
SPRED – Religious Education for Children with Special Needs...

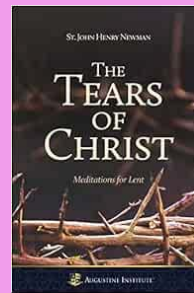
