Today's readings: Acts 1:1-11; Psalm 47:2-3. 6-7, 8-9 (6); Ephesians 1:17–23; Matthew 28:16–20.

YOU WILL BE MY WITNESSES

Our Scripture readings for almost every day of the Easter season have taken us progressively through the Acts of the Apostles. In this book, Luke pens with broad strokes the Church's development from the resurrection of Jesus to the



apostle Paul's first incarceration.

Today we flip back to the very beginning of Acts. In the opening scene, Luke sets the stage for the foundation of the Christian community, the Church. In just a few short lines of Scripture, we hear Jesus' final words to his disciples and witness his ascension to the Father. Jesus promises the disciples, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you," and proclaims, "You will be my witnesses . . . to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8). Thus launches the subsequent twentyeight chapters in which we hear the dramatic details about the experiences of the disciples, the powerful role of the Holy Spirit in the formation of the Christian community, and the spread of the Word of God.

It is often said that the most remarkable miracle of all those attributed to Jesus is the wildfire-like spread of the Gospel and the supersonic growth of the number of new Christians baptized. The Acts of the Apostles relates this miraculous emergence of the Church against all odds.

Dear People of Saint Gilbert's,


As this school year concludes, we congratulate all the graduates in the Class of 2023 and we offer this special prayer for them.






