

DIVINE MERCY

During the Jubilee Year of 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized Sr. Faustina Kowalska and declared that the universal Church would henceforth observe the Sunday after Easter as the Sunday of Divine Mercy. As we end the Octave of Easter, we are

invited to contemplate the mystery of the resurrection in the light of God's infinite mercy. The richness of God's mercy radiates through today's Scriptures and especially in Jesus' compassionate response toward Thomas' unbelief. The gift of mercy is explicitly given when Jesus commissions his disciples as ministers of divine mercy: "He breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained" (John 20:22-23). Through entrusting the first disciples with the gift of forgiving sins, Jesus initiated a waterfall of mercy for all of humanity. Sr. Faustina repeatedly heard a call to proclaim

God's mercy to the world.



divine mercy to raise spiritual awareness of God's mercy. Today, many Catholics will visit shrines devoted to divine mercy and pray the chaplet of divine mercy. Our Church announces to the world that God is merciful and that we are invited to rest in his loving embrace. May our hearts grow more aware of the mercy of God in our lives. In turn, may we actively show mercy to those who need it most.

Divine Mercy Sunday, April 16th

The Feast of Divine Mercy is celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. The image of Divine Mercy is blessed and venerated on the feast. The image is an icon of the resurrected Jesus with the inscription "Jesus I Trust in You". Two rays emanate from the heart of Jesus: a pale ray denotes Water and the red ray denotes Blood. These symbolize the blood and water which flow from the pierced heart of Christ on the cross.

The feast of Mercy is celebrated on the octave of Easter. In Old Testament tradition, the octave represents covenant. In Catholic tradition, major feasts have an octave feast. The primary feast, Easter, celebrates the resurrection and the promise of eternal life. The octave feast, Divine Mercy, celebrates the sacrament of reconciliation and restoration of sinners through the gift of the Merciful Savior.

Please continue to pray for our students who will receive First Communion this April and for those students who will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation this May.




