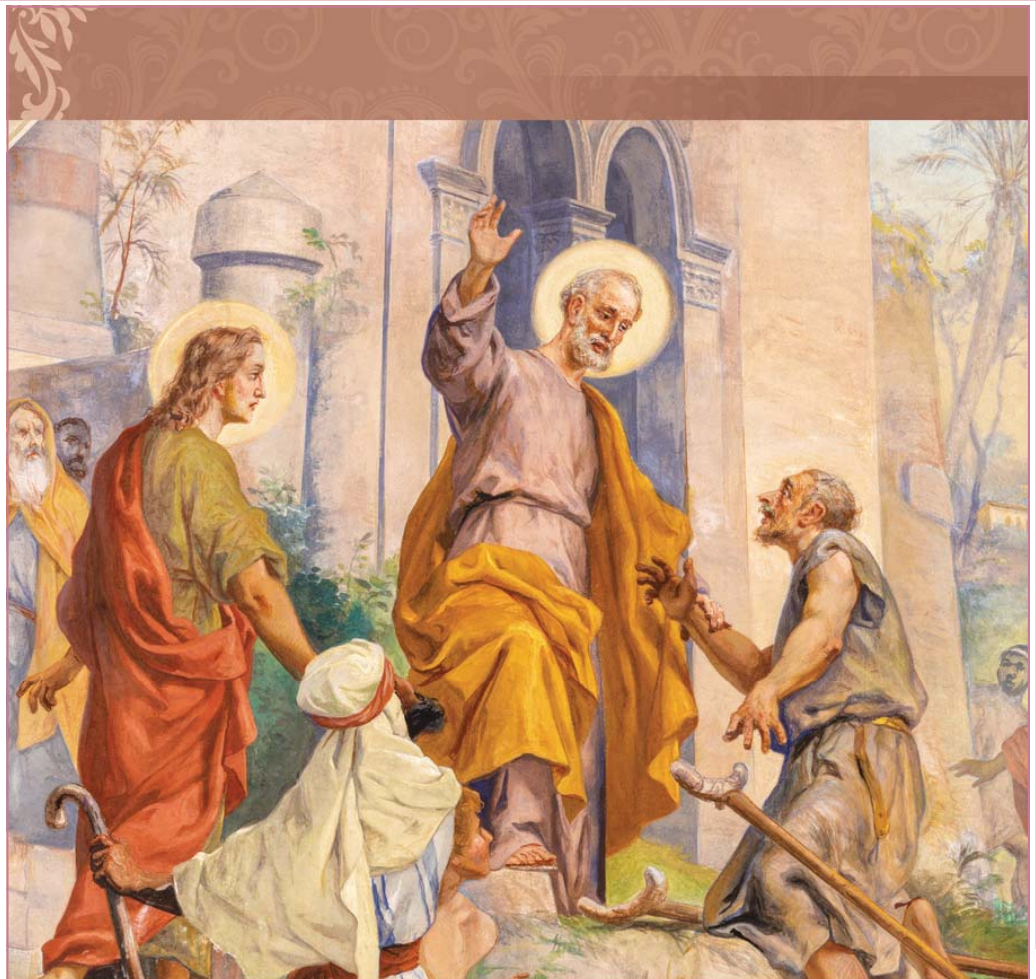

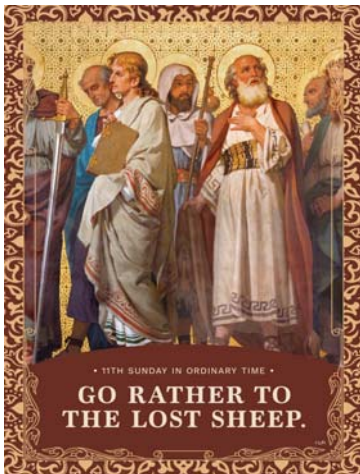

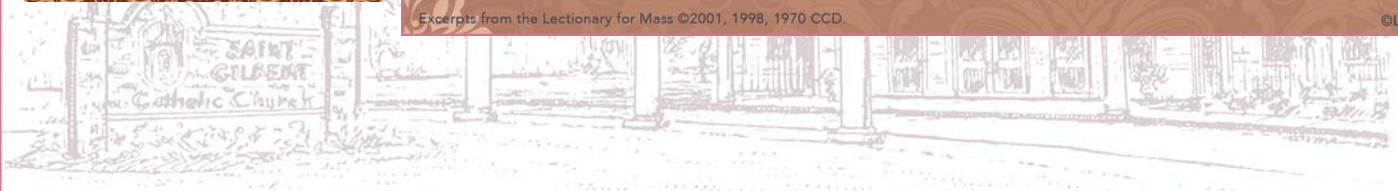

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

When Catholics come together and reminisce about the past, inevitably they recall the priests of their parishes. They may recall father's foibles and the funny moments they shared with their priests, but they also remember the priests whose ministry marked many holy moments — baptisms, Holy Communion, marriage preparation, visits to the sick and dying, comforting grieving families, and celebrating new beginnings. Priests have been there for all of us. And that summons us to gratitude.

This is for the 26/27 school year. **All requests are NOT CONSIDERED APPROVED UNTIL YOUR MINISTRY OR GROUP RECEIVES AN APPROVED CALENDAR BACK FROM THE BUSINESS OFFICE.** All groups must follow the rules for our facilities, and any group found to be in violation of those rules are subject to removal from future facility requests. You can request a form at business.office@stgilbert.org

TOP 5 RULES FOR FACILITY USAGE TO ALL GROUPS AND ORGANIZATIONS:

1. ALWAYS LIFT TABLES AND/OR CHAIRS WHEN MOVING THEM. THE FLOOR CAN BE DAMAGED FROM DRAGGING THESE ITEMS.
2. ANYTHING BROUGHT TO YOUR MEETING (Food and Non-Food) MUST BE REMOVED WHEN DEPARTING. NOTHING WILL BE WAREHOUSED ON PROPERTY.
3. ALL DOORS MUST REMAINED LOCKED IF THEY ARE LOCKED WHEN YOU ENTER. NO DOOR MAY BE PROPPED OPEN AWAITING ATTENDEES. USE A TEXTING SYSTEM OR STATION A PERSON AT THE DOORWAY FOR SAFE AND EASY ACCESS.
4. EVERYTHING SHOULD BE CLEANED BEFORE LEAVING. PLEASE LEAVE ALL ROOMS IN BETTER CONDITION THAN YOU FOUND THEM.
5. ALL GARBAGE MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE BUILDING AT THE END OF YOUR MEETING OR EVENT.

are to give.”



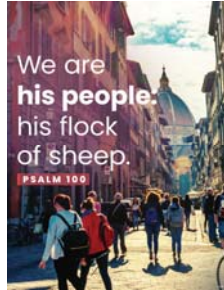

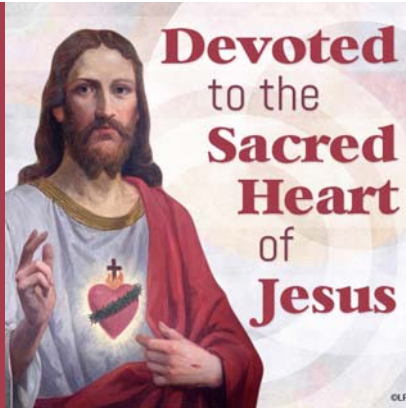

I remember seeing a story on a morning news program about a little girl who wanted to give an elderly man in a grocery store a hug. She had no way of knowing that this man had just lost his wife of many years and now felt so very alone and depressed. Her reaching out to the man seemed odd to her mom at first, but the girl was so insistent about giving a hug she moved the shopping carts close together so the exchange could take place. No one knew that from that moment on the little girl would ask to visit her new friend at least once a week for the next four years until he passed away. In an interview soon after the initial encounter, the man said, "I haven't been this happy in some time." Imagine the joy that relationship brought to them both over the years!
