How do we fast?

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Am I excused from fasting and abstinence?

Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women.

THE SEDER...

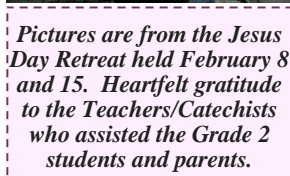

Ministers of Care (MOCs) are St. Gilbert parishioners that you see at the end of Mass on Sunday who come to the altar and are given the Eucharist by the Priest. 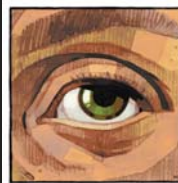

Dear Friends,
Next week we will begin the Lenten season. This season gives us an opportunity to reach out to those in need in a special way. We are so happy that St. Gilbert Parish has chosen Foundation for Children in Need, a Catholic Lay Organization, as a Lenten cause for this year. **We want to thank Father John and the entire parish community for giving us this honor and privilege.** We will journey with you during Lent and share more about our work in each week's bulletin. Let us walk together, giving alms, fasting and praying to help all those poor people who struggle on a daily basis, just to live another day. We are confident that sharing our stories of hope and outreach will enrich you during this Holy Lenten Season.

F.C.N. had humble beginnings when we started our office in Arlington Heights in 2002. **Father Bill Zavaski**, our Pastor Emeritus, was gracious and generous to welcome us into St. James Parish community.

The mission and vision of F.C.N. is to provide opportunities for Catholic Communities in the U.S. to reach out and bring hope to the poor and needy in the villages of India. Each summer we travel to

many Parishes around the country making appeals for three reasons: 1.) to promote the needs of people in the villages of India, 2.) to request for prayers 3.) to raise financial support for education, health care and self-sustaining economic solutions.

God has richly blessed us and FCN. Today, *F.C.N. is able to sponsor more than 1700 children and college students and 100 elderly.* We have built several schools, student residences, two homes for the aged and a community health center.
