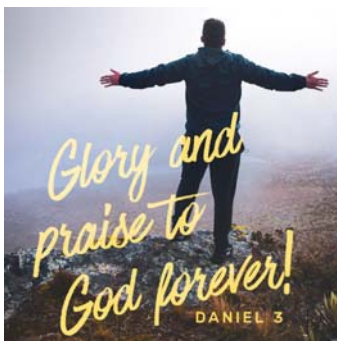

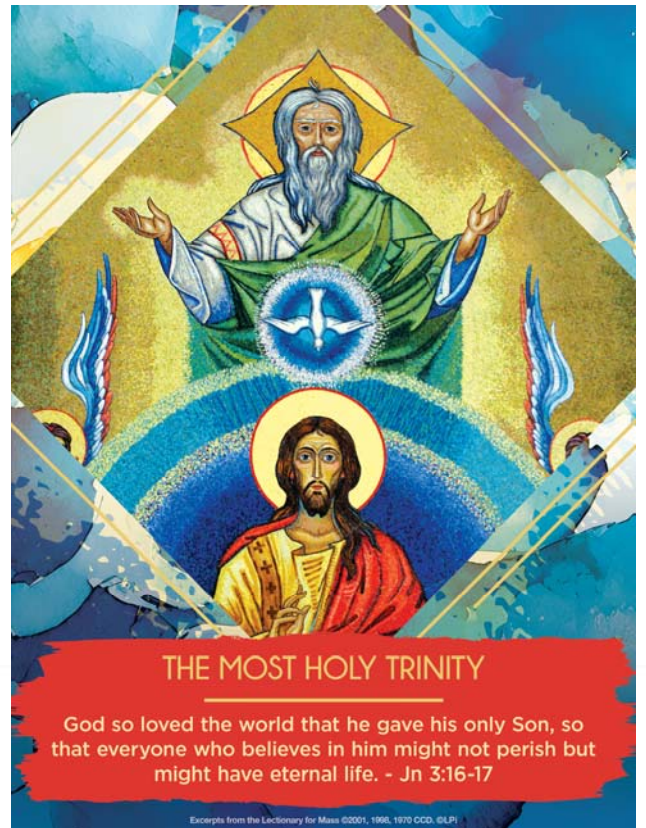

## GETTING TO KNOW OUR GOD

After years working for the Church, I can honestly say that even though I feel closer to God, I still cannot fully grasp all that is God. The complexity of God has been the source of many volumes by many writers and theologians. The crazy reality of growing in a relationship with God is that the more you get to know God, the more complex God becomes.

[...] I think that is true of human relationships as well. I feel like I can really peg a person one way or another after only meeting him or her a few times, but my wife and children continue to perplex me. Getting to know someone means you begin to uncover the layers of personality, feeling, and emotion that make up each human being. For those who see God as only a force or a light, God is simply defined. But for those who seek to be disciples of Jesus Christ, the God we find in relationship has many layers as well.

[...] That which we do know for certain about God comes to us primarily from the person of Jesus. He called us to a way of life by not only teaching us about how to live, but by showing us the example of his life. Our God is defined by generosity, sacrifice, compassion, and, of course, love. The more we incorporate these characteristics into our own life, the more we bear witness to the true nature of God. Then others can see a God that is a little less complex because they understand him through you and me. Our life will speak more than all the volumes written by all the theologians.

Here at Saint Gilbert, we feel it most appropriate to return this option to our celebration of Holy Mass beginning the weekend of June 11th, as we celebrate the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ.

**COMMUNION MINISTERS PLEASE NOTE:** In preparation for this new beginning, communion ministers are asked to stay after any Mass **THIS WEEKEND** for a short & simple refresher on this ministry of the cup.

Along with this development, we are in need of recruiting **MORE COMMUNION MINISTERS!** If you have discerned an interest in serving in ministry at Mass, please talk to one of the clergy or contact the parish office!

*Important Reminder: Please note that with the reception of the cup, the practice of intinction (dipping of the host into the wine) is not permitted in the Archdiocese of Chicago. It is important to remember that the fullness of the grace of Eucharist is present in both the consecrated bread and the wine and reception of both is not required. **SACRAMENT PREP...** There will be no summer classes for Grades 1-6 this year.
