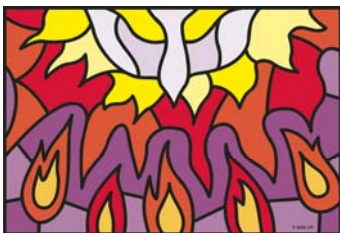

## COME HOLY SPIRIT!

With the celebration of Pentecost, we have traveled on a ninety-day journey since Ash Wednesday. Throughout Lent we watched for signposts in the Scriptures directing our hearts toward God. At Easter we committed (some of us for the first time and the rest of us once again) to our journey of faith in the risen Christ. As we journeyed through the weeks of Easter, Jesus continually beckoned us to remain close and promised to give us the Holy Spirit. The Spirit will bind us to one another and to God.

The promised gift of the Holy Spirit is affirmed on Pentecost. Before today's Gospel, we acclaim, "*Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.*" The gifts of the Holy Spirit—wisdom, understanding, counsel, strength, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord—assure us that God is cultivating and nurturing us to life within him. We carry the Holy Spirit within us and radiate that Spirit to all we meet. With the Spirit dwelling within us, we are always close to God. Today this truth of our faith is celebrated!

Take time this week to note the gifts of the Holy Spirit that you depend upon the most. Pray for a strengthening of the gifts of the Holy Spirit to help you on your daily walk as a disciple of the risen Christ. Come Holy Spirit!

## A Word...



Dear St Gilbert Parishioners and friends,

This weekend the joyful season of Easter concludes with the celebration of Pentecost, the fulfillment of Christ’s promise to send the Holy Spirit to strengthen and empower his disciples. Although the Paschal Candle which was first lit from the blessed new fire at Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday is now extinguished and moved from its place of prominence in the sanctuary to its usual spot next to the baptismal font, its light continues to radiate the warmth and power of the Holy Spirit which abides within the hearts of believers.

St Basil the Great, a church father of the fourth century, explains the Holy Spirit’s role in our lives: “*The Spirit restores paradise to us and the way to heaven and adoption as children of God; he instills confidence that we may call God truly Father, and grants us the grace of Christ to be children of the light and to enjoy eternal glory*” (From the treatise by Basil the Great on The Holy Spirit).

Rather than merely marking the end of Easter and return to the routine of Ordinary Time, I like to think of today’s solemn observance as a special feast of thanksgiving for the grace of the truly blessed season which is now past, and a beginning point on our pilgrimage through the remainder of the year. We are called, transformed, blessed and sent into the world to share good news of what God has done for us in Christ our Savior, and the magnitude of this mystery fills our hearts with gratitude and joy.

I’d like to offer a special word of thanks to our parish and school staff, and the many dedicated ministers and volunteers, whose hard work and devotion helped to make our celebration of Holy Week and Easter truly special this year. In particular, thanks to our wonderful clergy for presiding over and assisting at our liturgies, to **Mark Konchan, Cameron Normand and Paul Spheeris**, our music ministry leaders, and the choirs and accompanists, for their gift of musical worship, to the Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Altar Servers, Ushers and Mass Coordinators, and to **Raul and Gloria Venzon**, our Environment coordinators, for their outstanding service.

I’m also deeply grateful to **Kathleen Karigan** and the Confirmation Team Leaders, **Sr Donna** and the Catechists for preparing the First Communion celebrations, the SPRED team, **Kris Buckley** and the school faculty for preparing the Roaring Rebels Class of 2023 for graduation, and numerous others who helped organize and prepare meaningful parish and school celebrations during the season of Easter.

Finally, I’m honored and delighted to welcome back to Saint Gilbert the newly ordained **Fr Peter Lewitzke, OP**, as our celebrant for 9 AM and 11 AM Masses this weekend. A Grayslake native from a family of long-time St Gilbert parishioners, Fr Peter was ordained to priesthood last weekend in St Louis, and joins us for Pentecost Masses of Thanksgiving. The entire St Gilbert community extends heartfelt congratulations to Fr Peter and his family on the occasion of his priestly ordination, with prayers that his ministry among God’s people may be fruitful and pleasing to the Lord.

To paraphrase St Paul’s Letter to the Philippians (1:6), may God who has begun all these great works in us bring them to completion.
