**Dear Parents,**

The great adventures of the summer make it difficult to think about fall and the beginning of the Grades 7-9 Program. Regardless, it is time to think about the fall classes. If you haven't registered, please do so or bring the registration form with you to sign-up. You can find one on the website, [www.stgilbert.org](http://www.stgilbert.org), at the entrances to the Church, or from our office. If you can, please pay the full tuition before the end of September. If you want to be placed on a payment program, inform Lisa P. at the time of sign-up or call her in the office on Monday or Wednesday mornings, 9:00 – 12:00 noon.

Here is the fall syllabus. Look over it carefully with your son/daughter.

***If your son/daughter will be in Grade 7 and/or is the first one in the family to go through the Grades 7-9 Program, there is a meeting on Saturday, August 27 at 4:00 pm in the Multi-Purpose Room just for you.*** It will include an explanation of the program as well as an opportunity to sign-up for classes. Your student is certainly welcome to come and sign-up for him/herself.

Sign-up will begin at 4:00 pm on August 27 and continues until 4:45 pm in the hall outside the parish center. If you are unable to come on Saturday, August 27, you can sign up on Sunday morning on Google forms or call the office <https://forms.gle/yH4LFkc94oRvYUCCA>.

Students who have graduated from St. Gilbert School and who are going to one of the area Public High Schools must register in the Religious Education Program. These students are asked to obtain 10 credits during this year to enable them to enter the Confirmation Program in Grade 10. ***(I ask that these students do not take the 3 and 4 credit hour courses. These have been covered at St. Gilbert School.)*** I encourage these students to take courses during the year! Don't wait until the summer!!!!

Students are asked to contact the Food Pantry to make arrangements for service. Michael will set up a plan with the student to assist in a variety of ways: to collect, distribute or stack food. In some instances, parents will be asked to accompany the student with the project.

***Service Opportunities with Youth Ministry***

***Service*** – The Ministry of Altar Server is recognized as an important ministry in the parish. For every 10 Masses that the student serves he/she will earn 1 credit under service. Simply keep a record

of the date and time of service and hand it in to the Religious Education Office. Note that the student can earn only a total of 3 credits for service.

**Service – INTERNATIONAL FEST XVI – OCTOBER 23**

There will be opportunities to assist the International Fest XVI on Sunday, October 23. The fest runs from 12:00 noon to 2:30 pm. The volunteers will work 1 ½ hours for 1 credit and times will run 11:30 am- 3:30 pm (includes clean up).

**C. *Introduction to the New Testament and the Study of the Gospels – 4 Credits***

Sunday mornings 8:55 – 10:10 am

September 18, 25, October 2, 16, 23, 30, November 6, 13, 20, Dec. 4, 11

The purpose of this course is to enter more fully into one part of the Sacred Scripture, the New Testament. This study will give the student a deeper understanding of Jesus and what he means for us and for the world. The Gospels will be explored as to the person of Jesus, his life, and his teaching. Becoming familiar with the parables, miracles and the death of Jesus, etc. will bring students new understanding of the scriptures.

**D. *Commandments – 3 Credits***

Sunday mornings, 8:55 – 10:10 am

September 18, 25 October 2, 16, 23, 30, November 6, 13

This course will begin with the story of Exodus and the giving of the Commandments to Moses and the Israelites. Each Commandment will be discussed including the virtue and value pertaining to it. The course will invite your son/daughter to renew his/her commitment to keep God at the center of their lives. Built on the foundational principle that each and every human life is sacred, the Commandments guide us in loving our neighbor as we love ourselves.

**G. *Retreat: HOLY FIRE – sponsored by the Archdiocese of Chicago – 3 Credits***

Saturday, October 15, 7:30 am – to around 3:30 pm

This is a meeting with other teens in the Chicago area to experience their faith through song and worship. The permission form needs to be completed and sent to the Religious Education Office. The forms are on the website. The students will meet the bus in the East Parking Lot. They are asked to bring a lunch. Return will be around 3:30 pm.

**N. *Sacrament of Reconciliation – 1 Credit***

Tuesday evening, November 8, 6:00 – 8:00 pm in Church

Preparation for and participation in the sacrament is the main element of this class.

**O. *Trinity – God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit 1 Credit***

Sunday mornings, 8:55 – 10:10 am

November 20, December 4 and 11

This session walks the students through the three fundamental scriptural images of God (the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit) and probes their meaning and implications.

**X. Credits earned by attending these programs with Youth Ministry**

***Teen Ministry – TGIF 2 Credits (Grade 8 and High School) in the Teen Room***

Sunday evening, 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Dates for the Fall Semester: September 18, October 16, 30, November 6, and December 4, 18  
STUDENTS ATTEND FOUR SESSIONS FOR TWO CREDITS. Only 2 credits can be earned this way. Forms are available at sign-up or from the RE office.

***L.I.F.E. – LIVING IN FAITH EVERYDAY (GRADES 6 – 8) STUDENTS ATTEND 3***

***SESSIONS AND RECEIVE 1 CREDIT. (Two credits can be earned this way.)***  
Sunday afternoon, 4:00-5:30 pm in the teen center. Grade 8 students can choose TGIF or L.I.F.E. events. L.I.F.E. nights are September 18, October 16, 30, November 6, December 4, and 18.

There is a form in the Religious Education Office to be used in reporting the sessions you have attended
