### Parish Council Notes from September 10, 2019

#### Call to Order:

7:05 PM. Opened with hymn Canticle of the Sun, Fathering and Mothering God prayer.

## **Review of Previous Meeting Minutes:**

- Letty's PowerPoint Presentation to the council
  - 73% ordained prayed the rosary regularly and 75% spent regular time in adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Decrease in priest vocation, 59K priest to 36.5K in the past 50 years. Hence, Renew My Parish push.
  - o What can SGC do to mitigate these risks?
    - Need to emphasize need for prayer & offer more opportunities for prayer.
      - Daily rosary group prays every day after morning mass, 8:30-9am, but we need to highlight this on the website and bulletin.
      - Knights used to offer a rosary program monthly
      - **ACTION:** Dave to check with the Knights to find out if they have an apostolate to the rosary & will get back to us.
      - ACTION: Council to discuss whether we will add a prayer of vocation to the end of mass at the next PPC meeting on 10/22
      - ACTION:
        - 1. Determine whether SGC will promote Eucharistic Adoration, prayer for priests, & vocations with visiting PJP2 monstrance, 24 hours with confession. Have to call & schedule.
        - 2. Eucharistic Adoration Association will present as well.
        - **3.** Display panels, free of charge
        - **4.** Sign up as committed adorer in the narthex
  - Feast of the Rosary coming up on Oct 7.
    - ACTION: Fr. John approved the purchase of 200 rosaries with pamphlets on how to pray the rosary for October 7. DONE
    - ACTION: Letty to order the rosaries and pamphlets. DONE
  - In a 2019 PEW survey, 50% of Catholics stated they do not believe in the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Letty believes this is true in our church.
    - Symbol vs. True presence, need to reeducate so the parish comes alive with believing in His presence.



- What about the teens? Kathleen Faurbo
- **ACTION:** Requires more discussion with the council such as:
  - Can we remind our parish in our teachings, true presence, Eucharistic adoration at masses?
  - Also speak to the ministries to talk about the true presence.
  - Council to discuss with Fr. John & Fr. Christian if they can emphasize in their homilies to deliver a reminder lesson
- Other opportunities this year in the Spring
  - Walk through mass through Formed.org.
  - ACTION: Daphne to reach out to Deacon Mark and Fr. Christian to see if they might be willing to lead a session for parishioners
  - Word on Fire also has one
  - ACTION: Council needs to discuss other programs to offer so more people are praying, in need of support
    - Susan Tassone Purgatory Lady
    - Tim Francis Science Tests Faith Event -this is an opportunity that might be coordinated by St. Joes in Libertyville but could present at several parishes in the are on successive nights
- <u>PPC recruitment</u> Patti Wulf & Dave Rennolds attended from Women's Club & Knights of Columbus; they will begin participating in the 2019 school year.
  - ACTION: Letty & Daphne will review the draft bylaws from the Chicago Archdiocese APC and provide feedback to the council on creating our own.
- Bible Study Group slated to start 9/22,23,24
  - o 3 Sessions offered
    - 1. Sun 9:00am, MPR
    - 2. Mon 9am Chapel Hall,
    - 3. Tue 7:00pm Chapel Hal
  - o Cathy Green, Tom Parkinson, Michele Ecklund will facilitate
  - 45 confirmed participants
  - ACTION: Daphne will speak to Michele about making sure they get into the weekly announcements.
- Discipleship
  - ALPHA positive feedback from week 1
    - Huge time commitment & money investment initially, spent several thousands in preparations for the event. Can we get monetary support from Women's Club or KofC?
    - Mid-program retreat scheduled for Oct 19, 9-4 pm
    - ACTION: Dave Rennolds will ask Jim O'Brien & provide feedback to the group.
    - **ACTION:** Patti will check with the Women's Club if they can help as well.
    - Free will offering basket going forward
    - ACTION: Fr. John will make sure the bathrooms get cleaned.

- 1. Liturgy & Prayer Sunday, Adoration. Invite to learn about the faith, religious ed, Spred, Alpha
- 2. Faith Formation Bible Study
- 3. Community Building & Outreach
  - a. Want to be part of something bigger. Getting people together around a purpose. Outside of the community.
  - b. Partner with the community. Building relationship. Who willing the public face to the church?
  - c. Need a person in charge of faith formation.
  - d. What's available to me? Think creatively.
  - e. STRATEGIC direction -

  - g. Retreat in future planning. Stake out, chart the course to do.
